II. Purpose of Addendum

On June 22, 2009 a request was received to reduce the capacity of the facility to four residents instead of six residents.

III. Methodology

6/17/2009 Renewal inspection completed

6/22/2009 Document received to reduce the capacity from six residents to four residents.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

Advanced Teaching Concept Inc. filed an original application for a license and special certification for four residents on December 10, 2002 to provide care for four Developmentally Disabled residents.

On June 24, 2004 a temporary license was issued for four residents. The license was renewed on March 5, 2005 and June 21, 2007 for six residents.

On June 17, 2009 I conducted an on-site inspection for the purpose of renewing the License. At that time I observed only four resident beds. I spoke to Ms. Cogar, the Licensee Designee at the time. She amended the application.

On June 22, 2009 a letter was received from Ms. Cogar, requesting the capacity of the license be changed from six residents to four residents,

V. Recommendation

I recommend the capacity of the license be decreased from six residents to four residents.
