## II. Purpose of Addendum

The licensee filed a "Request For Modification of the Terms of the License/Registration" form. In that form Ms. Wynsma requested the capacity of the facility be increased from three to four AFC residents.

## III. Methodology

06/29/2009-Received request for capacity increase.

07/01/2009-Announced inspection of the facility. Measured the proposed resident bedroom and interviewed Ms. Wynsma.

## IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

There is an upstairs bedroom at this facility that is presently being used as a computer room. Ms. Wynsma would like to convert this room as an AFC resident bedroom.

Portions of this bedroom have a ceiling which is less than 6'6" in height and the area under that height is not counted.


Countable room dimensions of this room are listed under bedroom #3 heading

Bedroom #	Room Dimensions	Total Square Footage	Total Resident Beds
1	9'10" x 9'9"	95.84	1
2	14'3" x 9'9"	138.93	2
3	9'7" x 11'1"	104.37	1

The living, dining, and TV room areas measure a total of 514.57 square feet of living space. This exceeds the minimum of 35 square feet per resident requirement. Based on the above information, it is concluded that this facility can accommodate **four (4)** residents. It is the licensee's responsibility not to exceed the facility's licensed capacity. The facility is not approved for wheelchair dependent residents. This facility holds special certification status but already has interconnected smoke detectors. The licensee was advised that special certification rules require twelve fire drills per year for facilities with an AFC resident capacity of four or more.

**V. Recommendation**

It is recommended the capacity of this facility be increased to **four (4)** AFC residents.
