IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

Licensee has added a kitchen, dining room, family room, bedroom and bathroom to her existing adult foster care home. The addition connects to the foster care home through a passage way that also contains the laundry and heating unit for the addition. The home has an interconnected alarm system in both sections of the house. The addition is in compliance with adult foster care family home fire safety requirements.

The addition does not impact the resident living area of the home at all. Licensee reported she is able to hear the call buttons in the resident bedrooms from anywhere in the house.

V. Recommendation

No change in the license is required as the resident living environment is not impacted by the addition.
