II. Purpose of Addendum

The purpose of this addendum is to change the use of space of this facility, making the lower level (walk-out basement) usable for resident recreational purposes.

III. Methodology

The licensee submitted a request for modification of space of this facility. I conducted an onsite inspection, and the licensee submitted a revised evacuation drawing for this facility.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

This facility has been licensed to the current licensee since 8/31/1990. The home has a walkout basement, with a large double-door exit at the walk-out ground level, a second exit door directly to the outside, and a third exit up the stairway into the main level of the home. The entire basement meets the rules regarding fire safety, including rules regarding interior finish and the placement of smoke detection alarms. One large area is furnished with a television center and comfortable seating. A second room is furnished with a television with Wii and other exercise equipment, and is designated as the "workout area."

V. Recommendation

I recommend that the lower level (walk-out basement) of this facility be approved for resident recreational use.
