**II. Purpose of Addendum**

To increase the bed capacity of the Legacy at the Oaks home from 29 to 30.

**III. Methodology**

On June 7, 2011, an opening survey was conducted by the Bureau of Health Systems at the Legacy of the Oaks. This project consisted of renovation of room 306 to reconfigure the room to become a licensed bed location. The previous location of the window in the room obstructed the 20 foot required view from the window. The bathroom was moved from one side to the room to the other to allow space to relocate the window. The licensed bed count of the facility will be increased by 1 for a total licensed bed count of 30. At that time, the Bureau of Health Systems required documentation of final Bureau of Fire Services approval of the project in order to approve occupancy.

**IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions**

The Bureau of Fire Services granted final approval of this project on 6/29/2011.

**V. Recommendation**

I recommend an increase in the licensed capacity of the Legacy of the Oaks from 29 to 30.
