III. Methodology

10/30/2014: Received request to add mentally ill to population served
11/07/2014: Received revised program and admission statements; application to modify specialized program certification

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

Country Manor Home has been licensed since 11/01/2014 and served a population of developmentally disabled adults as a specialized program. They have now revised their program and admission statements to include adults with mental illness in their population served. Residents will be compatible. Direct care workers have been trained to serve both populations. LADD has applied to include mental illness as a specialized program.

V. Recommendation

I recommend the addition of mental illness to the program type for the license and special certification. A change in the license status is not required.
