II. Purpose of Addendum

Licensee requested a modification of terms to increase the capacity from 4 residents to 6 residents.

III. Methodology

On December 16, 2014 an onsite inspection was conducted.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The licensee has two bedrooms on the southeast side of the home which previously were utilized for private space by the licensee and her family. The licensee would like to utilize the bedrooms for residents. There are two bedrooms, each measuring 10' X 11'8" for a total of 116 SF each which exceeds the required space of 80 SF for an individual bedroom. Each room was fully equipped as required with a bed, dresser, and adequate closet space. Each room has a battery-operated smoke detector and an easily openable window. There is an additional battery-operated smoke detector in the hallway. There are two full bathrooms for resident use; one on the upper level of the home and one on the main level, which is the same level as the two additional bedrooms.

V. Recommendation

I recommend approval to increase the capacity from 4 to 6 residents.
