## II. Purpose of Addendum

On November 13, 2015, I received a written request submitted by Kathryn Simpson, the licensee designee, for an increase in capacity from 3 to 6 for Bigelow CLF, 10539 Bigelow, Davisburg, Michigan.

## III. Methodology

On 12/4/2015, I conducted an on-site inspection to evaluate the facility's compliance with all applicable licensing rules pertaining to environmental health, fire safety and physical plant.

## IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

On 12/4/2015, the resident bedrooms were measured and the dimensions are as follows:

Bedroom #1 contains 183 square feet of usable floor space and can accommodate up to 2 residents.

Bedroom #2 contains 191 square feet of usable floor space and can accommodate up to 2 residents.

Bedroom #3 contains 183 square feet of usable floor space and can accommodate up to 2 residents.


The living room and the family room contain a total of 377 square feet of living space and this exceeds the requirements for 6 occupants.

The facility can accommodate a maximum of 6 residents.

The facility is in substantial compliance with all applicable licensing rules pertaining to environmental health, physical plant and fire safety.

## V. Recommendation

I recommend that the terms of the license be modified and the capacity increased from 3 to 6 residents.
