II. Purpose of Addendum

On July 15, 2015, I received a request for an increase in capacity. The facility is requesting that the capacity be increased from 51 beds to 61 beds. The facility has completed their construction and received the approvals required for this increase.

III. Methodology

On December 28, 2015 the facility received an approval from the Bureau of fire services.

On January 7, 2016, I completed a walk through of the facility and found it to be in compliance with licensing rules.


On January 20, 2016, Health facilities Engineers approved the project and identified 32 available beds on the memory care side of the facility and 29 beds the assisted living side of the facility. The total capacity of the facility is 61 residents.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The facility has added a beautiful common area for the residents to use. It has plenty of windows and room for activities. The facility is equipped to handle the increase in capacity.

V. Recommendation

It is recommended that the capacity be increased to 61 beds available for residents.
