**II. Purpose of Addendum**

The Willows at East Lansing is requesting to convert a wing in the facility from nursing home to HFA occupancy. They are aware that with this change the nursing home beds will be forfeited. The HFA bed count will be increasing from 24 to 36, and the nursing home bed count will be decreasing from 80 to 68.

**III. Methodology**

Received an email from Kathy Corbin, the Director of Licensing, Trilogy Health Services, LLC, informing the department that they would like to increase the total number of home for the aged beds from 24 to 36.

A revised application was received 1/25/16, from Brad Williamson, Vice President, Trilogy Health Care of Clinton LLC, to increase license capacity to 36.

Laura Remus, from Health Facilities Engineering Section, sent transmittal sheets and room sheets on 1/19/16, to increase the occupancy to 36. Occupancy approval was given 1/19/16.

**IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions**

Laura Remus, from Health Facilities Engineering Section provided the facility transmittal sheet on 1/19/16, increasing the total bed capacity to 36. This 12 bed increase will decrease the total occupancy of the attached nursing home by 12.

The beds being changed are located in the 400 wing and are contiguous to the HFA portion of the building. Room sheets are on file from the initial opening survey and specify over 1400 sq-ft of day/dining space dedicated to the Home for the Aged.

**V. Recommendation**

I recommend increasing the licensed capacity of this home from 24 to 36, as of 2/29/16.
