The licensee requested to increase the facility’s capacity from three to five residents.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

During my onsite inspection on 11/17/17, the licensee Karen Williams stated she wanted to increase her capacity by two residents; therefore, I measured Bedroom #3 and instructed Ms. Williams to submit a modification request.

On 11/21/17, Ms. Williams submitted a modification request to convert her bedroom (Bedroom #3) into a bedroom for residents’ use. Ms. Williams stated she will now sleep in the basement to accommodate an additional two residents, increasing her capacity from three to five residents. The home continues to have 682 sq. ft. which is sufficient living and activity space for the proposed occupants of the home.

The bedroom space is as follows:

I recommend that the facility’s capacity be increased to five residents.


