II. Purpose of Addendum

To increase the capacity of this facility from 3 to 4 residents.

III. Methodology

03/20/2018 I received a written request from Licensee Josephine Mujeni requesting I visit the facility to measure a perspective resident bedroom and raise the facility capacity from 3 to 4 residents.

03/20/2018, I reviewed the Original Licensing Study Report to verify that this home has the required living space. The living, dining, and sitting room areas measure a total of 370 square feet of living space. This exceeds the minimum of 35 square feet per occupant requirement.

03/22/2018 I made an onsite inspection and measured the proposed resident bedroom. The room measured 10'x10' for a total of 100 square feet, which exceeds the 80 square feet requirement.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The proposed bedroom was measured and contains the required amount of space. The bedroom contains a closet, bed, mirror, and chair. The bedroom window opens easily, the door does not lock, and the room contains a slider to a deck.

V. Recommendation

I recommend the capacity of this home's license be increased from 3 to 4 residents.
