## II. Purpose of Addendum

To approve a bedroom formerly not used for residents as a resident room, but not to increase the capacity of the home. The room will just be used as a private, or single, bedroom.

## III. Methodology

On 09/04/2018, during the renewal inspection, Wilma Yates, Licensee, requested that a bedroom not originally approved for resident use be measure and approved for resident use. The request was not to increase capacity of the home, just to have another bedroom available for resident use as a private, or single, bedroom.

On 09/04/2018, I measured the proposed bedroom. The room measured at 11' X 10'7" for a total of 116 square feet, which exceeds the required amount of bedroom space. The room was also completely furnished and had a side-hinged door with latching device.

As the use of this bedroom does not mean an increase in capacity, the required amount of living space is still being met according to the Original Licensing Study Report.

## IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The proposed bedroom for resident use was measured and meets the square footage requirement. The room is fully furnished and has a side-hinged door with latching device.

## V. Recommendation

I recommend that the proposed bedroom formally not used by residents be approved for resident use.
