II. Purpose of Addendum

The purpose of this addendum is to increase the facilities licensed resident capacity from 5 residents to a maximum of 6 residents.

III. Methodology

August 2, 2018 – email from Licensee Rebecca Yonkman requesting an increase in licensed capacity. She will use a vacant bedroom which had previously been measured and inspected by this consultant and found to meet licensing criteria for resident use.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

This bedroom had been previously measured and inspected by this consultant and found appropriate for resident use. The bedroom measures 14' X 13' or 182 square feet of usable floor space. It may be used by one or two residents.

The common use area totals 463 square feet of space and will accommodate 6 residents plus the Licensee's family members.

V. Recommendation

I recommend the licensed resident capacity be increased to a maximum of 6 residents effective immediately.
