IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions


On 3/18/2019 I received a request to increase the licensed capacity from 3 to 5.

On 4/1/2019 I contacted the licensee Jennifer Spomer and scheduled an inspection at the facility for 4/2/2019.

On 4/2/2019 I conducted an on-site inspection at the facility. A full bath was added to the second floor of the home. The second-floor bedroom was measured and was 12'X12' for a total of 144 sq. ft. with two beds. An interconnected smoke detection system with battery back up was installed in the facility.

V. Recommendation

It is recommended that the capacity be increased to 5.
