II. Purpose of Addendum

The authorized representative requested an increase in licensed bed capacity allowing double occupancy in three rooms.

III. Methodology


Health Facilities and Engineering Section engineer, Pier-George Zaroni, reviewed the facility room sheets and determined the three rooms proposed for double occupancy were of sufficient size to accommodate two residents. In addition, day, dining, and bathing room requirements for the facility were determined to meet compliance, allowing for an increase in capacity from 24 to 27 residents.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

Licensing and Health Facilities and Engineering agree that this facility meets requirements to allow for an increase in capacity from 24 to 27. Rooms 6, 11, and 19 are designated as double occupancy.

V. Recommendation


I recommend the capacity for this facility be increased from 24 to 27 residents.
