Mills Haus was originally licensed on 10/19/2016 to accept a total of three male residents. The facility would now like to accept both male and female residents. The licensee designee, Heather Nadeau, submitted the facility’s updated program statement to reflect accepting both male and female residents. The licensee has additional facilities with both male and female residents; therefore, she has experience working with both populations within one facility. Ms. Nadeau reported she would only accept female residents who would not be placed at risk with the male residents.

Mills Haus was also originally licensed as having a total of three bedrooms with each bedroom containing one bed. The facility does not need to change the layout of the facility or any bedrooms in order to accommodate female residents.
