II. Purpose of Addendum

On June 18, 2019, I received an email from licensee designee, Michael Piagentini and administrator Timothy Nye regarding reallocation of some of the beds in their facility. Mr. Piagentini and Mr. Nye turned an office into bedroom #10 as this facility will no longer have 4 beds in a room.

III. Methodology

On August 5, 2019, I conducted an on-site inspection. At this time, I evaluated bedroom #6 (reduced # of beds from 4 to 3) and bedroom #10, which was the office in the floor plan in the file.


IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

Bedroom #	Room Dimensions	Total Square Footage	Total Resident Beds
6	20'2" x 14'2"	285	3
10	13'11" x 11'11"	166	1

Bedroom #6 still exceeds the minimum requirements for a multioccupancy. Bedroom #10 exceeds the minimum requirements for a single occupancy bedroom. Bedroom #10 was equipped with a door with the approved hardware and has an easily operable window.

V. Recommendation


The floor plan reflects the change in bedroom occupancy. The licensed capacity remains the same. I recommend no change to the license.
