II. Purpose of Addendum

The facility requested a decrease in licensed capacity from 88 beds to 65 beds based on a trend of declining admissions and lack of interest in sharing double occupancy rooms.

III. Methodology

On 7/8/19, an email was received from authorized representative Beth Satchell requesting an occupancy decrease from 88 to 65 beds. Operational details were included with the request. Per Ms. Satchell, no structural changes will occur, just having room designations changed. On 7/18/19, an email was received from Ms. Satchell with a floor plan relative to the occupancy decrease request.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The room conversion includes a reduction of two-bed capacity rooms 106, 107, 108, 109, 110, 117, 126, 201, 202, 204, 205, 206, 303, 304, 401, 402, 403, 404, 405, 406, 407, 408 and 409 to a one-bed capacity.

V. Recommendation


It is recommended that the bed capacity of Shields Comfort Care be decreased to 65 beds.
