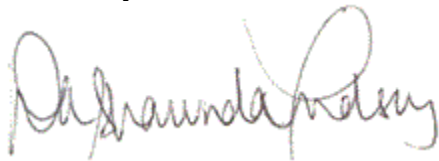

ALLEGATION:

Resident A was sexually assaulted at the group home.

INVESTIGATION:

On 07/09/2019, I received the allegations from adult protective services (APS).

On 07/09/2019, I conducted a telephone call to APS specialist Tina Edens. She verified she is investigating the allegations.

On 07/09/2019, I conducted a telephone interview with licensee designee Porchia Durant. Ms. Durant denied Resident A was sexually assaulted in the group home. According to Ms. Durant, Resident A is "mad because staff has been helping her to wash up." Ms. Durant acknowledged she washed Resident A's vaginal area, but she denied sexually assaulting her.

On 07/09/2019, I conducted an onsite investigation. I interviewed Resident A and B as well as staff Sandra Anthony.

Resident A stated Ms. Durant and staff Cassandra Green (she was not sure if that was the staff's name) sexually assaulted her. Ms. Durant and Ms. Green give her showers. While in the shower, they spread her legs open and wash her body, including her "clitoris", "vagina" and "butt." Resident A denied that Ms. Durant and Ms. Green do anything else to her, including any other type of physical touch, while showering. Resident A stated she does not want staff to wash her up.

Resident B stated the only staff are Ms. Durant and Ms. Anthony. She denied ever observing Ms. Durant or Ms. Anthony sexually assault Resident A.

Ms. Anthony did not know who Ms. Green was. According to Ms. Anthony, the only staff in the facility are Ms. Durant and herself. Ms. Anthony verified she has washed Resident A; however, she denied ever washing her private parts, including her "clitoris", "vagina" and "butt." Ms. Anthony stated she only wash Resident A's back, arms, legs and hair. Ms. Anthony denied ever forcing Resident A to take a shower. She stated she "coaches" Resident A to shower. Ms. Anthony denied ever observing Ms. Anthony or any other person sexually assault Resident A.

During the onsite investigation, I reviewed Resident A's assessment plan. Per the plan, staff are to assist Resident A with using the bathroom, bathing/showering when needed and making sure she is groomed properly. The assessment plan was not signed by or dated by Resident A's guardian. It is not known if Resident A's guardian reviewed and approved Resident A's plan.


On 08/14/2019, I conducted an exit conference with licensee designee Porchia Durant. I informed her of the findings. She agreed to submit a corrective action plan.

APPLICABLE RULE	
R 400.14305	Resident protection.
	(3) A resident shall be treated with dignity and his or her personal needs, including protection and safety, shall be attended to at all times in accordance with the provisions of the act.
ANALYSIS:	Ms. Durant, Ms. Anthony and Resident B denied observing Resident A being sexually assaulted in the home. Ms. Durant and Ms. Anthony acknowledged they washed Resident A, but they denied sexually assaulting her. Resident A stated staff sexually assaulted her by spreading her legs open and washing her body, including her clitoris and vagina and butt. Resident A denied that Ms. Durant and Ms. Green do anything else to her, including any other type of physical touch, while showering.
CONCLUSION:	VIOLATION NOT ESTABLISHED

APPLICABLE RULE	
R 400.14301	Resident admission criteria; resident assessment plan; emergency admission; resident care agreement; physician's instructions; health care appraisal.
	(4) At the time of admission, and at least annually, a written assessment plan shall be completed with the resident or the resident's designated representative, the responsible agency, if applicable, and the licensee. A licensee shall maintain a copy of the resident's written assessment plan on file in the home.
ANALYSIS:	Per Resident A's assessment plan, staff are to assist Resident A with using the bathroom, bathing/showering when needed and making sure she is groomed properly. The assessment plan was not signed or dated by Resident A's guardian. It is not known if Resident A's guardian reviewed and approved Resident A's plan.
CONCLUSION:	VIOLATION ESTABLISHED

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommended issuance of a 1st provisional license in Special Investigation Report #2019A0993042, which remains in effect.


