ALLEGATION:

Resident A's roommate has been sexually inappropriate with or towards him.

INVESTIGATION:

On 2/18/2020, a complaint was received and assigned for investigation alleging that Resident A's roommate has been sexually inappropriate with or towards him.

On 2/21/2020, I conducted an unannounced on-site investigation at which time I interviewed the home manager, Monica Glover. I was unable to interview Resident A as he was hospitalized for psychiatric treatment. Ms. Glover stated she has worked at the Pitt Home since 12/2019 and has been employed with the company for the past four years. Resident A has resided at the Pitt Home for three years and has been with the company for over 10 years. Ms. Glover stated Resident A's first hospitalization was on 2/6/2020. He was discharged back to the home on 2/18/2020 but admitted again on 2/21/2020 for suicidal ideations. According to Ms. Glover, Resident A and Resident B were roommates prior to Resident A's hospitalization. When he returned to the home on 2/18/2020 he stated he no longer wanted to be roommates with Resident B but gave no explanation as to why. Ms. Glover asked Resident A if Resident B had done anything to him and he said no. Resident A was moved into the room with Resident C. After the move, Resident A then stated he wanted Resident B and Resident C to move out of the home all together.

On 4/24/2020, I spoke with Ms. Glover by telephone and was informed that Resident A returned to the home on 3/5/2020. She said he and Resident C seem to be getting along now and she had no complaints to report.

On 4/24/2020, I interviewed Resident A by telephone. He denied that Resident B had been sexually inappropriate with him and wanted to know who made the complaint. It was difficult for Resident A remain on topic during the interview. He began talking about terrorists, Donald Trump and that all black people including Obama are going to be killed. This is all the information I was able to extract from Resident A.


On 4/24/2020, I left a message for the licensee designee, Gloria Campbell informing her of the investigative findings and recommendation of the investigation.

APPLICABLE RULE	
R 400.14305	Resident protection.
	(3) A resident shall be treated with dignity and his or her personal needs, including protection and safety, shall be attended to at all times in accordance with the provisions of the act.

ANALYSIS:	Based on the information obtained from Resident A and Ms. Glover, there is insufficient information to determine that Resident A's roommate was sexually inappropriate with or towards him as Resident A denied the allegations.
CONCLUSION:	VIOLATION NOT ESTABLISHED

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend the status of the license remain unchanged.
