II. Purpose of Addendum

The purpose of this addendum is to decrease resident capacity from eight to seven residents.

III. Methodology

On November 10, 2020 I received a telephone call from administrator Karla Calloway who stated the facility is currently licensed for eight residents, which is incorrect because the facility has seven single occupancy bedrooms and can only accommodate seven residents. On November 11, 2020 I received a written Request for Modification of the Terms of the license from licensee designee Jennifer Lockhart wherein Ms. Lockhart explained that the facility has seven resident bedrooms and none of them are double occupancy, thus the facility can only be licensed for seven residents. Ms. Lockhart included a written copy of the facility floor plan.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

Based on a statement from Ms. Calloway and written information submitted by Ms. Freeman it appears the facility can only accommodate seven residents in total.

V. Recommendation

I recommend the capacity be decreased from eight residents to seven residents.
