II. Purpose of Addendum

A request was made by the facility authorized representative Steven Tyshka to reduce the facility's licensed bed capacity from 80 to 50.

III. Methodology

2/24/21 - Received email from Mr. Tyshka requesting change in capacity. Mr. Tyshka provided a revised BCAL 1600 application reflecting the change in bed count.

3/1/21- Operational narrative received, signed by Mr. Tyshka.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

Mr. Tyshka explained that the new bed count is a result of going from double occupancy to single occupancy in units 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 8, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 28, 31, 33, 34, 35, 38, 39 and 40. Mr. Tyshka reported that double occupancy will remain in units 5, 7, 9, 26, 27, 29, 30, 32, 36 and 37.

V. Recommendation

I recommend the proposed change to the licensed bed capacity take place effective immediately. The status of the license will remain unchanged.
