II. Purpose of Addendum

The facility has requested to reduce the licensed capacity of 15 double occupancy into single occupancy rooms.

III. Methodology

On 2/19/21, licensing was notified by the facility authorized representative Steven Tyshka that de-licensing 15 beds was requested. Mr. Tyshka requested resident rooms numbered: 104, 114, 120, 121, 202, 204, 206, 207, 210, 211, 219, 220, 221, 227, and 228 be reduced to one licensed bed each.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

On 2/19/21, I reviewed the room sheets for the facility. The rooms that are to be licensed for one bed were originally licensed for two beds. I find no conflicts with identified room reduction to single occupancy.

V. Recommendation


I recommend the license capacity to be lowered to 61 beds.
