The facility renovated the former memory care unit of the third floor, Ashlar Terrace, into a common living area, dining area, nurse station, laundry room, storage, and eight resident suites.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The facility renovated the third floor, Ashlar Terrace.

The unit now has eight resident suites that allow for double occupancy. Residents can choose from a studio floor plan or a two-bedroom suite. The studio apartment offers a small kitchen area with a sink, refrigerator, and counter space. The apartment offers build in cabinets for additional storage. The two-bedroom apartment offers an entryway closet, galley kitchenette, walk in closet, and two bedrooms. All apartments are outfitted with a bathroom that contains a sink, toilet and walk in shower with grab bars and optional bench seating. Within the bathroom there is an emergency pull cord for residents to summon staff assistance.

Within the unit there is a common living area, dining area, nurse station, laundry room, and resident storage. Residents can choose to eat in the dining area on Ashlar Terrace or go to the main dining area on the first level.

I reviewed marketing information for the facility and found no marketing of memory care programming within the home for the aged areas.

V. Recommendation


I recommend the removal of Alzheimer's program designation and the license to reflect 221 licensed beds.
