II. Purpose of Addendum

The licensee requested to make the two resident bedrooms into five resident bedrooms to provide more privacy.

III. Methodology

02/01/2021 – Contact – Document Received – Received modification request

02/01/2021 – Contact – Document Sent – Advised facility of rule requirements for bedroom and living spaces

03/11/2021 – Inspection completed on-site – measured bedrooms

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The facility was originally licensed on 09/23/2016 with two resident bedrooms. One of the bedrooms consisted of four resident beds while the other resident bedroom consisted of two resident beds.

To provide more privacy to the residents, the licensee made the four resident bedroom into three private/individual bedrooms. In addition, the licensee put a wall in one of the former living rooms to create a single resident bedroom. All the additional bedrooms have windows as means of egress and the required furniture for resident bedrooms.

The measurements of the resident bedrooms are the following:

Bedroom #	Room Dimensions	Total Square Footage	Total Resident Beds
1	14.5 ft x 7.3 ft	105 sq ft	1
2	14.5 ft x 7.8 ft	113 sq ft	1
3	10.6 ft x 9 ft	95 sq ft	1
4	14.5 ft x 10.7 ft	155 sq ft	2
5	10 ft x 9.3 ft	93 sq ft	1

The remaining living and dining areas measure a total of 540 sq. ft. of living space. This continues to exceed the minimum of 35 square feet per occupant requirement.

The licensee also submitted an updated evacuation plan reflecting the current floor plan.

V. Recommendation

I approve the licensee's request to create four private resident bedrooms within the facility effective 07/02/2021.
