III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This facility was found to be in non-compliance with the following rules:

R 325.1922 Admission and retention of residents.

(5) A home shall update each resident's service plan at least annually or if there is a significant change in the resident's care needs. Changes shall be communicated to the resident and his or her authorized representative, if any.

Review of resident files revealed Resident A's service plan was not updated annually. Resident A's service plan was last updated on 6/11/20 and lacked documentation of communication of the plan changes with Resident A's authorized representative. Resident B and Resident C service plans lacked documentation of communication with their authorized representatives.

VIOLATION ESTABLISHED

R 325.1932 Resident medications.

(1) Medication shall be given, taken, or applied pursuant to labeling instructions or orders by the prescribing licensed health care professional.

Review of Resident A's medication administration record (MAR) revealed the following medications were not initialed as given Johnson's Baby Shampoo on 7/21, Azasite 1% Eye Drops on 7/15, 7/16, 7/17 and 7/18, and Tobramycin-Dexamethasone suspension on 7/21 and 7/22.

Review of Resident B's MAR revealed the following medications were not initialed as given Acetaminophen on 6/16, Bacitracin ointment on 6/28, 6/29, 6/30 and 7/1, and Ropinirole on 6/16.

Facility staff did not mark any reason for the missed doses and the MARs were left blank, therefore it cannot be confirmed why the medication administration was not completed as scheduled.

VIOLATION ESTABLISHED

R 325.1979 General maintenance and storage.

(3) Hazardous and toxic materials shall be stored in a safe manner.

At the time of inspection, Resident B's room had oxygen tanks unsecured along the walkway entering his room. There were five small oxygen tanks, two medium sized oxygen tanks and one large oxygen placed against the wall. The oxygen tanks were not stored securely to prevent them from falling nor in a proper location.

VIOLATION ESTABLISHED

On 7/22/2021, I shared the findings of this investigation with facility authorized representative Steven Tyshka. Mr. Tyshka verbalized understanding of the citations.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

Contingent upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, renewal of the license is recommended.
