#### III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This facility was found to be in non-compliance with the following rules:

#### R 400.14511 Flame-producing equipment; enclosures.

Heating plants and other flame-producing equipment located on the same level as the residents shall be enclosed in a room that is constructed of material which has a 1-hour-fire resistance rating, and the door shall be made of 1 3/4-inch solid core wood. The door shall be hung in a fully stopped wood or steel frame and shall be equipped with an automatic self-closing device and positive-latching hardware.

- (2) A permanent outside vent that cannot be closed shall be incorporated in the design of heating plant rooms so that adequate air for proper combustion is assured.
- (3) Combustible materials shall not be stored in rooms that contain heating equipment, a water heater, an incinerator, or other flame-producing equipment.

The furnace enclosure does not have a 1-hour fire rating. Vents/opening leading to the inside of the home were observed.

The furnace enclosure does not have a 1-hour fire rated door. **Technical Assistance** 1&3/4" solid wood core door or equivalent.

The furnace enclosure does not have a permanent outside vent that cannot be closed.

**Technical Assistance** The combustion air must be directly from the outside through noncombustible ductwork with a permanently opened vent and ducted to approximately 12" off the floor. If the heat plant room contains an outside wall, adequate combustion air may be provided through a louvered permanent opening or a permanently opened window.

The furnace enclosure also contains the wash machine and dryer. Storage of items to do the laundry cannot be kept in the furnace enclosure. Linens, clothing, soap, and bleach were observed in the furnace enclosure.

**Technical Assistance** Combustible materials refer to those materials which catch fire, burn, or smolder, when subjected to various degrees of heat. Such materials would include, but are not limited to, flammable liquids, paper, cloth, wood, plastic, vinyl, leather, etc.

#### IV. RECOMMENDATION

Contingent upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, renewal of the license is recommended.

The door shall be hung in a fully stopped wood or steel frame and shall be equipped with an automatic self-closing device and positive-latching hardware.

The heat plant enclosure inside walls were not constructed of material which has a 1 -hour-fire resistance rating.
