ALLEGATION: Resident A was mistreated by staff Alfornia Webster

INVESTIGATION: Resident A was not interviewed due to his developmental disabilities.

On 4/13/2022, I interviewed Faith Hinson, program coordinator, who stated direct care staff, Alfornia Webster, used an inappropriate physical management hold on Resident A and that he escalated the situation to the point of requiring unnecessary

force. She stated the incident did not warrant the level of physical restraint he utilized.

On 4/13/2022, Stephanie Harris, program coordinator, stated Alfornia Webster's employment was terminated on 4/1/2022, after an internal investigation.

On 4/14/2022, I interviewed direct care staff, Nash Wadi. He stated on 3/31/2022, he was requested by direct care staff Alfornia Webster to assist in restraining Resident A. Nash Wadi stated that Alfornia Webster called Resident A an idiot and stupid. He stated Alfornia Webster said that Resident A needed to be physically managed roughly so he (Resident A) would know who was in control. Finally, he stated that when physically managing Resident A, Alfornia Webster was using excessive force because Resident A was not being combative.

On 4/14/2022, I interviewed Resident A's guardian, William White. He stated he was very satisfied with Resident A's placement and the services he is receiving at Eisenhower Center.

On 4/14/2022, I called Alfornia Webster but he did not answer the telephone or return my call.

On 4/14/2022, I conducted an exit conference with Don Adams, licensee designee.

APPLICABLE RULE	
R 400.15308	Resident behavior interventions prohibitions.
	(1) A licensee shall not mistreat a resident and shall not permit the administrator, direct care staff, employees, volunteers who are under the direction of the licensee, visitors, or other occupants of the home to mistreat a resident. Mistreatment includes any intentional action or omission which exposes a resident to a serious risk or physical or emotional harm or the deliberate infliction of pain by any means.

ANALYSIS:	<p>04/13/2022, Faith Hinson, program coordinator, stated direct care staff, Alfornia Webster, used an inappropriate physical management hold on Resident A</p> <p>04/14/2022, Nash Wadi, direct care staff stated Alfornia Webster, direct care used excessive force to manage Resident A.</p> <p>The preponderance of credible evidence is that direct care staff Alfornia Webster mistreated Resident A by using excessive force restraining Resident A and made disrespectful comments to him.</p>
CONCLUSION:	VIOLATION ESTABLISHED

IV. RECOMMENDATION

An acceptable plan of correction has been received; therefore, I recommend no licensing action.
