05/04/2022- I received a revised program statement for Barrett Regency.


05/11/2022- I reviewed the current license file, licensee designee’s experience, licensee’s information in BITS, and the revised program statement.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

Based on the information received and documents reviewed, the licensee designee, Sheila Leadbetter, is qualified to provide services to the traumatically brain injured population. Ms. Leadbetter has been a registered nurse for over 35 years and has extensive experience working with patients diagnosed with traumatic brain injuries. She also has experience working in home health care with TBI patients, assisting with cognitive/physical function and rehabilitation. Ms. Leadbetter will conduct a thorough assessment prior to accepting residents into the home to ensure that they are compatible with the other residents at Barrett Regency.

V. Recommendation

I recommend that traumatically brain injured be added to the program type for Barrett Regency.


