#### III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This facility was found to be in non-compliance with the following rules:

R 400.15301

Resident admission criteria; resident assessment plan; emergency admission; resident care agreement; physician's instructions; health care appraisal.

(10) At the time of the resident's admission to the home, a licensee shall require that the resident or the resident's designated representative provide a written health care appraisal that is completed within the 90-day period before the resident's admission to the home. A written health care appraisal shall be completed at least annually. If a written health care appraisal is not available at the time of an emergency admission, a licensee shall require that the appraisal be obtained not later than 30 days after admission. A department health care appraisal form shall be used unless prior authorization for a substitute form has been granted, in writing, by the department.

Resident A's resident file did not contain a current health care appraisal.

R 400.15301

Resident admission criteria; resident assessment plan; emergency admission; resident care agreement; physician's instructions; health care appraisal.

(4) At the time of admission, and at least annually, a written assessment plan shall be completed with the resident or the resident's designated representative, the responsible agency, if applicable, and the licensee. A licensee shall maintain a copy of the resident's written assessment plan on file in the home.

Resident A's resident file did not contain a current assessment plan.

#### R 400.15312 Resident medications.

- (1) Prescription medication, including dietary supplements, or individual special medical procedures shall be given taken, or applied only as prescribed by a licensed physician or dentist. Prescription medication shall be kept in the original pharmacy-supplied container, which shall be labeled for the specified resident in accordance with the requirements of Act No. 368 of the Public Acts of 1978, as amended, being S333.1101 et seq. of the Michigan Complied Laws, kept with the equipment to administer it in a locked cabinet or drawer, and refrigerated if required.
- There were medications stored in a pill reminder box in Resident C's room.
- There were medications stored in a pill reminder boxes in Resident D's room.

#### R 400.15312 Resident medications.

(3) Unless a resident's physician specifically states otherwise in writing, the giving, taking, or applying of prescription medications shall be supervised by the licensee, administrator, or direct care staff.

According to the licensee designee, Mike Dyki, there are four residents who self-medicate and keep their medication in their rooms. There were no physician statements contained in the resident files documenting that these residents can administer their own medication.

#### R 400.15316 Resident records.

- (1) A licensee shall complete, and maintain in the home, a separate record for each resident and shall provide record information as required by the department. A resident record shall include, at a minimum, all of the following information:
- (e) Resident care agreement.

Resident A and Resident B's resident files did not contain resident care agreements.

#### R 400.15402 Food service.

- (3) All perishable food shall be stored at temperatures that will protect against spoilage. All potentially hazardous food shall be kept at safe temperatures. This means that all cold foods are to be kept cold, 40 degrees Fahrenheit or below, and that all hot foods are to be kept hot, 140 degrees Fahrenheit or above, except during periods that are necessary for preparation and service. Refrigerators and freezers shall be equipped with approved thermometers.
- There were no thermometers contained in the refrigerator in the following resident rooms: #1106, #1109, and #1115.
- There were no thermometers contained in the freezer in the following resident rooms: #1109, #1115, and #1119.

### R 400.15403 Maintenance of premises.

(10) Scatter or throw rugs on hard finished floors shall have a nonskid backing.

There were throw rugs that did not contain nonskid backing in the following resident rooms: #1107, #1111, #1114, and #1128.

#### IV. RECOMMENDATION

Contingent upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, renewal of the license is recommended.
