II. Purpose of Addendum

Mr. Barber requested to decrease the capacity of the home for the aged (HFA) by eliminating 4 resident rooms previously numbered 270, 271, 254, and 255. Mr. Barber requested to change the number of assisted living beds to 61 beds and to change the number of memory care beds to 28 beds, totaling 89 beds for the facility.

III. Methodology


On 6/21/2022, Mr. Barber applied to decrease from 93 licensed beds to 89 licensed beds. On 8/1/2022, I completed an on-site inspection. The Health Facilities Engineering Section room sheets were reviewed for the rooms identified to have a decrease in beds.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

I reviewed HFES room sheets and determined rooms numbered 18 through 28, the eleven rooms are one licensed bed with 137 sq ft, built in closets, connected bathrooms. Day/dining space is adequate to support this decrease of 4 licensed beds.

V. Recommendation

It is recommended the license capacity decrease to reflect 89 licensed beds.
