III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This facility was found to be in non-compliance with the following rules:

R 400.14208 Direct care staff and employee records.

(1) A licensee shall maintain a record for each employee. The record shall contain all of the following employee information: (f)Verification of reference checks.

At the time of inspection, Staff= Char-zette Carter employee record reviewed did not contain two verification of reference checks.

R 400.14318 Emergency preparedness; evacuation plan; emergency transportation.

(5) A licensee shall practice emergency and evacuation procedures during daytime, evening, and sleeping hours at least once per quarter. A record of the practices shall be maintained and be available for department review.

At the time of inspection, the licensee failed to practice and maintain a copy of fire drills during evening hours for the second, third, and fourth quarters in 2021.

R 400.14408 Bedrooms generally.

(7) Bedrooms shall have at least 1 easily openable window.

At the time of inspection, I observed downstairs resident bedroom to be nailed shut.

R 400.14507 Means of egress generally.

(6) Occupied room door hardware shall be equipped with positive-latching, non-locking-against-egress hardware.

At the time of inspection, I observed two resident bedroom doors not equipped with positive-latching hardware.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

Contingent upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, renewal of the license is recommended.
