At the time of my inspection, I noted that the toilet handle in one of the resident bathrooms was not working properly. All plumbing fixtures shall be maintained in good working condition.

	(4) Interior doorways of bedrooms that are occupied by residents shall be equipped with a side-hinged, permanently mounted door that is equipped with positive-latching,
	nonlocking-against-egress hardware.
At the time of my inspection, I noted that several of the resident bedroom doors were not equipped with positive-latching, non-locking-against-egress hardware. All bedroom doors must be equipped with this hardware.
