#### III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This facility was found to be in non-compliance with the following rules:

# R 400.14315 Handling of resident funds and valuables.

- (3) A licensee shall have a resident's funds and valuables transaction form completed and on file for each resident. A department form shall be used unless prior authorization for a substitute form has been granted, in writing, by the department.
  - A review of the file for Resident A reflected that the accounting information on the Resident Funds Part II form was inaccurate.

#### R 400.14401 Environmental health.

- (2) Hot and cold running water that is under pressure shall be provided. A licensee shall maintain the hot water temperature for a resident's use at a range of 105 degrees Fahrenheit to 120 degrees Fahrenheit at the faucet.
  - The hot water temperature was 130 degrees Fahrenheit at the faucet.
  - The temperature on the water heater was turned down prior to the conclusion of the on-site inspection.

#### R 400.14407 Bathrooms.

- (3) Bathrooms shall have doors. Only positive-latching, non-locking-against-egress hardware may be used. Hooks and eyes, bolts, bars, and other similar devices shall not be used on bathroom doors.
  - The upstairs bathroom door was equipped with lockingagainst-egress hardware.

# R 400.14507 Means of egress generally.

- (5) A door that forms a part of a required means of egress shall be not less than 30 inches wide and shall be equipped with positive-latching, non-locking-against-egress hardware.
  - The screen doors leading to the first and second required means of egress were equipped with locking-againstegress hardware.

## IV. RECOMMENDATION

Contingent upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, renewal of the license and the special certification is recommended.
