# **III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS**

This facility was found to be in non-compliance with the following rules:

# R 400.14318 Emergency preparedness; evacuation plan; emergency transportation.

(5) A licensee shall practice emergency and evacuation procedures during daytime, evening, and sleeping hours at least once per quarter. A record of the practices shall be maintained and be available for department review.

At the time of inspection, Licensee failed to complete fire drills for daytime hours for first and second quarter in 2021; sleeping hours during the fourth quarter in 2022.

#### REPEAT VIOLATION LSR DATED 03/19/2021 AND CAP DATED 03/24/2021

### R 400.14403 Maintenance of premises.

(2) Home furnishings and housekeeping standards shall present a comfortable, clean, and orderly appearance.

At the time of inspection, I observed the following:

- Dust and cobwebs around all doorways and ceilings
- Bathroom tub peeling
- Grease covered stove hood filters

#### R 400.14407 Bathrooms.

(1) Bathrooms and toilet facilities that do not have windows shall have forced ventilation to the outside. Bathroom windows that are used for ventilation shall open easily.

At the time of inspection, I observed the resident bathroom ventilation to not be operable.

## R 400.14511 Flame-producing equipment; enclosures.

(4) Combustible materials shall not be stored in rooms that contain heating equipment, a water heater, an incinerator, or other flame-producing equipment.

At the time of inspection, I observed debris and old furnace filters near the water heater and furnace area.

#### IV. RECOMMENDATION

Contingent upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, renewal of the license is recommended.
