III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This facility was found to be in non-compliance with the following rules:

R 400.14401 Environmental health.

(2) Hot and cold running water that is under pressure shall be provided. A licensee shall maintain the hot water temperature for a resident's use at a range of 105 degrees Fahrenheit to 120 degrees Fahrenheit at the faucet.

FINDING: The water temperature from the bathroom sink located in the newest bathroom (i.e. what was once the garage area of the facility) was registering at only 68.5 degrees Fahrenheit despite the water running for several minutes.

REPEAT VIOLATION ESTABLISHED [SEE 2021 RENEWAL LICENSING STUDY REPORT, DATED 08/06/2021, CAP DATED 08/23/2021]

R 400.14403 Maintenance of premises.

(8) Stairways shall have sturdy and securely fastened handrails. The handrails shall be not less than 30, nor more than 34, inches above the upper surface of the tread. All exterior and interior stairways and ramps shall have handrails on the open sides. All porches and decks that are 8 inches or more above grade shall also have handrails on the open sides.

FINDING: The patio on the front of the facility, outside of the Administrator's office, was measuring higher than 8 inches on all sides, except the area right beneath the handrail that was attached to the facility. It appeared the concrete had dropped or sunk creating more distance from the top of the patio to the ground.

Exterior porches or decks elevated above grade level are to be enclosed with rails on the open sides if the elevation above grade is more than 8 inches.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

Contingent upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, renewal of the license and specialized certification for the developmentally disabled is recommended.
