Findings: This adult camp residential program operates at the licensed campsite Tamarack Camps #SR630200186. The camp facility is an outdoor residential camp facility including cabins, dining hall, health center, multipurpose activity buildings, and pavilions. The outdoor environment includes lakes, hiking trails, high adventure activity areas for target sports, aquatics, climbing, zipline, and ropes course. The adult program program utilizes a separate living quarters than the children's camp residential camp. The campsite meets applicable licensing rules to host this adult camp program.

B. PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Operation	Days and Times of Operation: Two sessions of Adult camp with variable lengths of session. Adult camper participate in a 10-day program or a 25 day program for each session.
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Staffing	Adult Staff to Camper Ratio: Adult to camper ratio are 1 adult to not more than three campers.

Findings: The adult camp program occurs inclusive camp experience simultaneously but separately from the children's camp program at Tamarack camps. The adult camp is for young adults between the ages of 18 and 28 years. Adult campers participate in residential camp activities involving arts and crafts, swimming, farming/harvesting, and horseback riding. Adult campers are supervised by trained adult staff. The adult camp program involves job coaching and recreation programs. The adult camp program meets applicable licensing rules.

C. RULE/STATUTORY VIOLATIONS

The camp PROGRAM were found to be compliant with statute and administrative rules.

RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of an original PROGRAM license to this adult camp.
