#### III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This facility was found to be in non-compliance with the following rules:

#### R 400.14203 Licensee and administrator training requirements.

- (1) A licensee and an administrator shall complete the following educational requirements specified in subdivision (a) or (b) of this subrule, or a combination thereof, on an annual basis:
- (a) Participate in, and successfully complete, 16 hours of training designated or approved by the department that is relevant to the licensee's admission policy and program statement.
- (b) Have completed 6 credit hours at an accredited college or university in an area that is relevant to the licensee's admission policy and program statement as approved by the department.

At the time of inspection Titus Duncan, licensee designee failed to provide verification of successfully completing, 16 hours of training or 6 credit hours at an accredited college or university in an area that is relevant to the licensee's admission policy and program statement as approved by the department.

#### R 400.14301

Resident admission criteria; resident assessment plan; emergency admission; resident care agreement; physician's instructions; health care appraisal.

(10) At the time of the resident's admission to the home, a licensee shall require that the resident or the resident's designated representative provide a written health care appraisal that is completed within the 90-day period before the resident's admission to the home. A written health care appraisal shall be completed at least annually. If a written health care appraisal is not available at the time of an emergency admission, a licensee shall require that the appraisal be obtained not later than 30 days after admission. A department health care appraisal form shall be used unless prior authorization for a substitute form has been granted, in writing, by the department.

At the time of inspection, Resident D's resident file did not contain an annual 2021 or 2022 health care appraisal.

#### R 400.14301

Resident admission criteria; resident assessment plan; emergency admission; resident care agreement; physician's instructions; health care appraisal.

(4) At the time of admission, and at least annually, a written assessment plan shall be completed with the resident or the resident's designated representative, the responsible agency, if applicable, and the licensee. A licensee shall maintain a copy of the resident's written assessment plan on file in the home.

At the time of inspection, Resident A's 2021 and 2022 annual assessment plans were not signed by her resident's designated representative.

#### R 400.14301

Resident admission criteria; resident assessment plan; emergency admission; resident care agreement; physician's instructions; health care appraisal.

(9) A licensee shall review the written resident care agreement with the resident or the resident's designated representative and responsible agency, if applicable, at least annually or more often if necessary.

At the time of inspection, Resident A's 2021 and 2022 annual resident care agreement were not signed by her resident's designated representative.

#### R 400.14315 Hand

#### Handling of resident funds and valuables.

(3) A licensee shall have a resident's funds and valuables transaction form completed and on file for each resident. A department form shall be used unless prior authorization for a substitute form has been granted, in writing, by the department.

At the time of inspection, Residents B and C resident's funds and valuables transaction form part II was not thoroughly completed and did not reflect accurate transaction and accounting information.

Resident B's transaction form did not reflect the correct social security income (SSI) amount received monthly from 01/2023 through 04/2023. The SSI amount documented was \$991.00. According to Resident B's SSI statement, she receives \$1141.00 monthly as of 01/2023.

Resident C's transaction form did not reflect the correct SSI amount received monthly from 01/2023 through 04/2023. The SSI amount documented was \$996.50. According to Resident C's SSI statement, she receives \$1088.00 monthly as of 01/2023.

#### R 400.14315 Handling of resident funds and valuables.

(8) All resident fund transactions shall require the signature of the resident or the resident's designated representative and the licensee or prior written approval from the resident or the resident's designated representative.

At the time of inspection, Resident A's funds and valuables transaction form part II did not contain the signature of her designated representative.

#### R 400.14315 Handling of resident funds and valuables.

(9) A resident's account shall be individual to the resident. A licensee shall be prohibited from having any ownership interest in a resident's account and shall verify such in a written statement to the resident or the resident's designated representative.

At the time of inspection, Resident's B, C, and D bank account statements were not available for review.

Kendra Paige, administrative assistance stated the resident funds are deposited into the company business account and they do not have individual bank accounts.

#### R 400.14403 Maintenance of premises.

(1) A home shall be constructed, arranged, and maintained to provide adequately for the health, safety, and well-being of occupants.

At the time of inspection, the bureau in Resident E's bedroom was not in good repair, the drawers were broken and off track.

#### IV. RECOMMENDATION

Contingent upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, renewal of the license is recommended.
