III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

R 325.1953	Menus.
	(1) A home shall prepare and post the menu for regular and therapeutic or special diets for the current week. Changes shall be written on the planned menu to show the menu as actually served.
	(2) A home shall maintain a copy of all menus as actually served to residents for the preceding 3 months.
ANALYSIS:	The interview with the facility's kitchen manager, along with my observations, revealed the current regular and therapeutic or special diet menus for the current week are not posted anywhere within the facility. The facility also has not maintained a copy of all menus as actually served to residents for the preceding three months.
CONCLUSION:	VIOLATION ESTABLISHED

This facility was found to be in non-compliance with the following rules:

R 325.1954	Meal and food records.
	The home shall maintain a record of the meal census, to include residents, personnel, and visitors, and a record of the kind and amount of food used for the preceding 3-month period.
ANALYSIS:	The interview with the facility's kitchen manager, along with my observations, revealed the facility has not maintained a record of the meal census, to include residents, personnel and visitors, and a record of the kind and amount of food used for the preceding three months.
CONCLUSION:	VIOLATION ESTABLISHED

R 325.1976	Kitchen and dietary.
	(5) The kitchen and dietary area, as well as all food being stored, prepared, served, or transported, shall be protected

	against potential contamination from dust, flies, insects, vermin, overhead sewer lines, and other sources.
ANALYSIS:	My inspection of the kitchen revealed several ceiling tiles above food preparation and cooking areas had visible and hanging dust particles. These areas were not protected from dust falling onto food items served to residents. It was evident the ceiling tiles were not cleaned or dusted regularly.
CONCLUSION:	VIOLATION ESTABLISHED

R 325.1976	Kitchen and dietary.
	(6) Food and drink used in the home shall be clean and wholesome and shall be manufactured, handled, stored, prepared, transported, and served so as to be safe for human consumption.
ANALYSIS:	My inspection of the walk in and reach in refrigerator revealed several food items were not labeled or dated. There was also an open bag of breadsticks in the walk in refrigerator. The bag was open to the elements and potential contamination.
CONCLUSION:	VIOLATION ESTABLISHED

IV. RECOMMENDATION

Contingent upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan and the annual renewal fee, renewal of the license is recommended.
