II. Purpose of Addendum

The licensee has requested to increase the capacity from nine to eleven residents.

III. Methodology

On 01/31/2024, an onsite inspection was completed at the facility to see the newly, furnished added bedroom.

On 02/01/2024, I exchanged emails with BFS, Ken Phillips.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The proposed main level bedroom was measured and found to exceed the minimum amount of space required (13'11" X 13'3"). The proposed bedroom contains a closet, bed, mirror, and chair. The bedroom contains a large window and standard construction door with adequate egress. The bedroom has adequate square footage to accommodate two residents, eleven residents in total. The facility has sufficient living space for all eleven residents. The additional space has also been approved by Bureau of Fire Services.

V. Recommendation

I recommend the facility's capacity be increased to eleven residents.
