III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This facility was found to be in non-compliance with the following rules:

R 400.1407 Resident admission and discharge criteria; resident assessment plan; resident care agreement; house guidelines; fee schedule; physician's instructions; health care appraisal.

(6) A licensee shall review the written resident care agreement with the resident or the resident's designated representative and responsible agency at least annually or more often if necessary.

The licensee failed to review the written resident care agreement annually. Resident A was admitted to the home on 06/09/2022. A resident care agreement was completed. No a resident care agreement for 2023 was not contained in the resident record.

R 400.1416 Resident healthcare.

(3) A licensee shall record the weight of a resident on admission and then monthly after that. Weight records must be maintained for 2 years.

The licensee failed to record each residents' weight monthly. If a physician believes it is not in the best interest of resident to be weighed monthly, due to inability to bear weight or sit in a wheelchair, this information needs to be contained in the resident's record.

R 400.1438 Emergency preparedness; evacuation plan; emergency transportation.

(4) Fire drills shall be conducted 4 times a year. Two of the 4 required fire drills shall be conducted during sleeping hours. A record of the fire drills shall be incorporated with the evacuation plan.

The licensee failed to conduct fire drills 4 times a year. The licensee did not have any documentation to show fire had been conducted 4 times a year.
