II. Purpose of Addendum

The purpose of the addendum is to add developmentally disabled and mentally ill to the program type of Briarfield.

III. Methodology

2/12/2024 - I received a phone call from the licensee designee, Kimberlee Waddell, requesting to change the program type for Briarfield to include developmentally disabled and mentally ill. A contract for services from Community Mental Health is currently being negotiated.

2/15/2024 – I received a revised program statement and special certification application for Briarfield.

3/04/2024 – I received and reviewed recipient rights training certificates for each staff member working at the Briarfield home as well as for Ms. Finney.

3/04/2024 – I reviewed the current license file, licensee designee and administrator's experience, licensee's information in BITS, the revised program statement, and the special certification application.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

Based on the information received and the documents reviewed, the licensee designee, Kimberlee Waddell and the administrator, Suzette Finney are qualified to provide services to the developmentally disabled and mentally ill population. Both Ms. Waddell and Ms. Finney are certified brain injury specialists and have extensive training and experience working with individuals who suffer from traumatic brain injuries and have physical and mental limitations. Ms. Finney also completed the required Recipient Rights training through Community Mental Health.

V. Recommendation

I recommend that developmentally disabled and mentally ill be added to the program type for Briarfield.
