ALLEGATION:

Facility environmental health inspection was unacceptable.

INVESTIGATION:

On 8/14/24, a complaint through the Bureau of Community Health Systems (BCHS) online complaint system alleged on 4/22/24 Calhoun County Health Department conducted an environmental health inspection for the facility’s private water and sewage disposal system and the sewage system failed with a D rating.

On 8/14/24, I reviewed Calhoun County Health Department Environmental Health Inspection (EHI) Report dated on 4/22/24. The report described health department inspector Leah Erlandson completed an inspection due to the facility having a private well and sewage disposal system. The report indicated the well water tested was ok but when the sewage system was tested it failed. Ms. Erlandson stated in the

report her final results as the following “Septic system has failed with sewage on the ground, recommend new septic system, and septic tank pumped.”

On 8/20/24, I conducted an onsite investigation interviewing licensee Sheri Loomis at the facility. Mrs. Loomis reported being aware on 4/22/24 Calhoun County Health Department conducted an environmental health inspection (EHI) due to the facility’s private water and sewage disposal system. Mrs. Loomis reported facility manager Tony Patrick was present when health department inspector Leah Erlandson was at the facility. Mrs. Loomis reported from what her worker told her was that Ms. Erlandson only indicated the septic tank needed to be drained and that the sewage system leach bed field was failing. Mrs. Loomis also denied receiving a copy of the EHI report knowing the facility failed receiving a D rating.

On 8/22/24, a follow up was made with licensee Sheri Loomis via telephone. Mrs. Loomis provided updated information about correcting the facility’s private sewage disposal system with hiring a licensed contractor and the changes to the system in the next couple weeks.

APPLICABLE RULE	
R 400.14401	Environmental health.
	(3) All sewage shall be disposed of in a public sewer system or, in the absence thereof, in a manner that is approved by the health authority.
ANALYSIS:	Interviews with the licensee Sheri Loomis and reviewing Calhoun County Health Department EHI report revealed on 4/22/24 the private water and sewage disposal system was inspected, and the septic system failed. Mrs. Loomis reported she has taken immediate steps in making corrections to the septic system.
CONCLUSION:	VIOLATION ESTABLISHED

On 8/20/24, I conducted an exit conference with licensee Sheri Loomis who reported that she understood the findings of the investigation and she would not be contesting the special investigation due to the EHI report with a D rating.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

Contingent upon receipt of acceptable corrective action plan and approved updated environmental health inspection report, no change in license is recommended.
