## II. Purpose of Addendum

On 6/4/24, McBride Quality of Care Director of Operations Sarah Nestle requested a modification for McBride #6's layout to include bedroom 6 as a single occupancy room and change bedroom #3 from a double occupancy to a single occupancy room. This would mean bedroom #1 is the only shared room.

## III. Methodology

05/31/2024 – Sarah Nestle emailed requesting the paperwork to complete a modification and allow use of the upstairs bedroom.

05/31/2024 – I reviewed the Original Licensing Study Report which indicated the downstairs bedrooms are used for residents and the second-floor bedrooms may be changed for resident use in the future because the home is wheelchair accessible.

06/04/2024 – Sarah Nestle submitted the Request for "Modification of the Terms of the Registration / License" with the above details.

06/14/2024 – Inspection completed on-site – Completed on-site inspection to measure the upstairs bedrooms.

## IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

An on-site inspection was completed on 6/4/24 to measure bedroom #6 to ensure it meets the space requirements of a resident bedroom.

I have received an updated floor plan with also shows the measurements of each resident bedroom. According to the floor plan and my measurements Bedroom #6 measures 15' X 11'5" which meets the space requirements of a resident bedroom. There is a full resident bathroom upstairs for resident use.

## V. Recommendation

I recommend bedroom #3 is changed from a double occupancy to a single occupancy room and bedroom #6 upstairs is added as a single occupancy bedroom.
