On 01/06/25 and 01/14/25, I requested a proposed budget from the licensee designee. At the time of my onsite inspection on 01/16/25 and as of 01/21/25, I have not received this document.

<p>At the time of my inspection, the administrator Tonya Burnett, was unable to submit a statement from a licensed physician attesting to her physical health. The licensee designee, Daniel Burnett stated that Tonya Burnett is on disability and is unable to obtain a copy of a doctor's statement attesting to her health.</p>

<p>At the time of my inspection, the administrator Tonya Burnett was unable to submit documentation that she has been tested for communicable tuberculosis within the past 3 years. The licensee designee, Daniel Burnett stated that Tonya Burnett is on disability and is unable to undergo tb testing.</p> <p>REPEAT VIOLATION ESTABLISHED Ref. 	(1) A licensee shall maintain a record for each employee. The record shall contain all of the following employee information: (f) Verification of reference checks.
<p>At the time of my inspection, the licensee was unable to provide verification of two employees' reference checks.</p>	
R 400.14401	Environmental health.
	(2) Hot and cold running water that is under pressure shall be provided. A licensee shall maintain the hot water temperature for a resident's use at a range of 105 degrees Fahrenheit to 120 degrees Fahrenheit at the faucet.
<p>At the time of my inspection, the hot water temperature at the large bathroom faucet was 128 degrees Fahrenheit.</p> <p>REPEAT VIOLATION ESTABLISHED Ref. SIR #2024A0872017, CAP dated 02/15/2024.</p>	

IV. RECOMMENDATION

Contingent upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, renewal of the license is recommended.
