IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

Based on the information received and documents reviewed, the licensee, Heather Sherry, is qualified to provide services to the TBI population. Ms. Sherry has been an Adult Foster Care provider for over two years. She has experience working with individuals who have traumatic brain injuries. Ms. Sherry has earned her Master of Social Work degree and has been working in social work for over 12 years at McLaren Hospice, as a medical social worker.

Ms. Sherry will conduct a thorough assessment prior to accepting residents into the home to ensure that they are compatible with the other residents at The Willows Senior Living.

V. Recommendation

I recommend that traumatically brain injured be added to the program type of The Willows Senior Living.


