III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This facility was found to be in non-compliance with the following rules:

R 400.14203 Licensee and administrator training requirements.

- (1) A licensee and an administrator shall complete the following educational requirements specified in subdivision (a) or (b) of this subrule, or a combination thereof, on an annual basis:
- (a) Participate in, and successfully complete, 16 hours of training designated or approved by the department that is relevant to the licensee's admission policy and program statement.

Licensee designee/administrator Raemicon Asugui did not complete 16 hours of annual training related to the admissions policy and program statement for 2023 and 2024.

R 400.14204 Direct care staff; qualifications and training.

- (3) A licensee or administrator shall provide in-service training or make training available through other sources to direct care staff. Direct care staff shall be competent before performing assigned tasks, which shall include being competent in all of the following areas:
 - (b) First aid.

I observed that direct care staff Edward Iberra and Carlos Almazon First Aid expired in 2022.

R 400.14204 Direct care staff; qualifications and training.

- (3) A licensee or administrator shall provide in-service training or make training available through other sources to direct care staff. Direct care staff shall be competent before performing assigned tasks, which shall include being competent in all of the following areas:
 - (c) Cardiopulmonary resuscitation.

I observed that direct care staff Edward Iberra and Carlos Almazon Cardiopulmonary resuscitation expired in 2022.

R 400.14207 Required personnel policies.

(2) The written policies and procedures identified in subrule (1) of this rule shall be given to employees and volunteers at the time of appointment. A verification of receipt of the policies and procedures shall be maintained in the personnel records.

I observed that direct care staff Edward Iberra and Carlos Almazon did not have verification of receipt of policies and procedures in their personnel records.

REPEAT VIOLATION ESTABLISHED. Licensing Study Report 03/27/2023, Corrective Action Plan 04/10/2023.

R 400.14207 Required personnel policies.

(3) A licensee shall have a written job description for each position. The job description shall define the tasks, duties, and responsibilities of the position. Each employee and volunteer who is under the direction of the licensee shall receive a copy of his or her job description. Verification of receipt of a job description shall be maintained in the individual's personnel record.

I observed that direct care staff Edward Iberra and Carlos Almazon did not have verification of receipt of job description in their personnel records.

REPEAT VIOLATION ESTABLISHED. Licensing Study Report 03/27/2023, Corrective Action Plan 04/10/2023.

R 400.14310 Resident health care.

(3) A licensee shall record the weight of a resident upon admission and monthly thereafter. Weight records shall be kept on file for 2 years.

I observed that Resident B was not weighed monthly since admission on 01/23/2025.

R 400.14312 Resident medications.

(2) Medication shall be given, taken, or applied pursuant to label instructions.

I observed that Resident A's following medications were not taken as labeled:

- Hyoscyamine SL 0.125 mg is to be taken every 4 hours. The medication was listed on the medication administration record for 8 AM and 7 PM.
- Lorazepam 1mg is to be taken every 4 hours. The medication was listed on the medication administration record for 7PM.
- Quetiapine 50mg I to be taken every 8 hours. The medication was listed on the medication administration record for 7PM.
- Haloperidol 1mg is to be taken every 4-6 hours. The medication was listed on the medication administration record for 7PM.

REPEAT VIOLATION ESTABLISHED. Licensing Study Report 03/27/2023, Corrective Action Plan 04/10/2023.

R 400.14401 Environmental health.

(8) Hand-washing facilities that are provided in both the kitchen and bathroom areas shall include hot and cold water, soap, and individual towels, preferably paper towels.

I observed that there was no soap and individual towels in the bathroom.

R 400.14402 Food service.

(4) All food service equipment and utensils shall be constructed of material that is nontoxic, easily cleaned, and maintained in good repair. All food services equipment and eating and drinking utensils shall be thoroughly cleaned after each use.

I observed that the stove top and oven were oily and unclean.

R 400.14402 Food service.

(6) Household and cooking appliances shall be properly installed according to the manufacturer's recommended safety practices. Where metal hoods or canopies are provided, they shall be equipped with filters. The filters shall be maintained in an efficient condition and kept clean at all times. All food preparation surfaces and areas shall be kept clean and in good repair.

I observed that the filter above the stove was dirty and oily.

R 400.14410 Bedroom furnishings.

- (1) The bedroom furnishings in each bedroom shall include all of the following:
 - (d) At least 1 chair.

I observed that in bedrooms one and two there was not at least one chair.

R 400.14410 Bedroom furnishings.

(2) A resident bedroom shall be equipped with a mirror that is appropriate for grooming.

I observed that in bedroom number four, there was no mirror.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

Contingent upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, renewal of the license is recommended.
