II. Purpose of Addendum

The purpose of this addendum to the original licensing study report is to change the use of licensed space in the facility. The home was originally licensed to have three double occupancy resident bedrooms and one bedroom designated as a den. The licensees would like to modify the original licensing study to change the use of space to two double occupancy resident bedrooms, two single occupancy resident bedrooms, and remove the use of a den.

III. Methodology

On 6/5/25 I conducted a two-year renewal inspection at the facility. I observed that the licensees had started using the area previously identified as a den on the original licensing study report, as a single occupancy resident bedroom. The licensees reported that they determined two of the current residents required private bedrooms and they modified the use of space to accommodate this request for privacy. During this on-site inspection I measured the space and observed the room dimensions to be 8'11ft x 10'8ft, totaling 95sqft of usable space. The room is equipped with a half bathroom, a closet, dresser, bed, chair, and mirror for resident use, as well as a window for emergency evacuation. The room has two doors, but each is private to the room and would not require someone to walk through the room to get to another area of the home.

On 6/12/25, the licensees, Ketema Beshah & Asnakech Mengistu, submitted a Modification Request form making a formal written request to permanently modify the terms of the license to change the use of space at the facility to include two double occupancy resident bedrooms and two single occupancy resident bedrooms.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

I have found that the space requested to be licensed as a single occupancy resident bedroom meets the criteria established in the adult foster care licensing rules to be considered a resident bedroom.

V. Recommendation

Modify the terms of the license to change the use of space from three double occupancy resident bedrooms and one den, to two double occupancy resident bedrooms, two single occupancy resident bedrooms, and no longer a space identified as a den.
