II. Purpose of Addendum

A modification to the original licensed capacity (5) is required due to a change in the facility’s use of space.

III. Methodology

On July 2, 2025, a renewal inspection was completed at the facility. The licensee and her family are residing in the home. Bedroom #2 on the first floor and Bedroom #3 on the second floor are now occupied by household members instead of residents. The licensee intends to move out of the facility in the future. Once the family has relocated, the licensee can submit a request to increase the licensed capacity back to five.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

Based upon the information provided above, this facility can accommodate 3 residents. It is the licensee’s responsibility not to exceed the facility’s licensed capacity.

V. Recommendation

It’s recommended that the facility capacity be decreased from five to three.


